### **Assessments - Years 2 and 6**

Our Year 6 pupils will be sitting the Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs) from Monday 14<sup>th</sup> May – Friday 18<sup>th</sup> May. Year 2 pupils will be assessed by their class teachers throughout May. These are national assessments and it is important that all children in years 2 and 6 are in school during this time.
