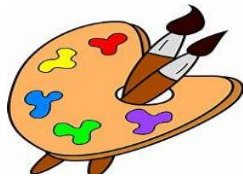
Money that was raised by parents, carers, friends and family last year will go towards the cost of the development.

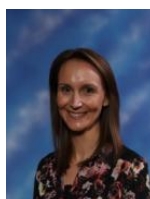
