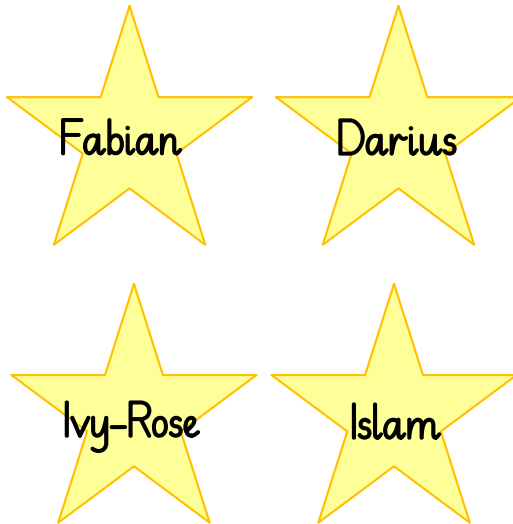

This Friday it is World Kindness Day. How can we show kindness to each other?

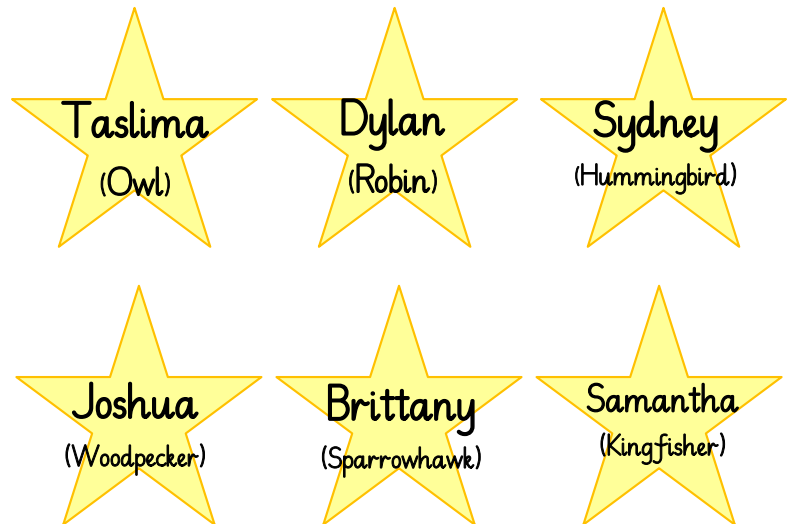
